

2017 GNR Visitor/Day Pass Policy

The following visitor/day pass policy is in effect for the 2017 Grand National Rally*. See details below.

If a member(s) would like to attend GNR for a day, they are able to access the grounds via a visitor/day pass this year. The rate is \$30 per day per WIT Club number. The member will need to register for the event with Heidi Fedders, as she will have name badges created and mailed ahead of time for access to the rally grounds. Registration will need to be completed by June 30. Instructions regarding entry and parking will be mailed along with name badges and a GNR Program. If after July 1, the visitor/day pass rate is \$40 per day per WIT Club number. Late-registration will need to be completed in Friendship Hall with Heidi Fedders via cash/check. Staff at the Visitors Center will ask questions and direct to grounds only if guest is eligible to attend the event (i.e. are a Winnebago owner and/or already a WIT Club member). Guest will arrive at the gate and Security will direct to park along fence line and radio WIT Club Staff to bring guest down to Friendship Hall. Badges and a GNR Program will be given at that time.

Parking for visitor/day pass guests will be just inside the main gate off of Highway 69 near the GNR Shuttle Bus Stop. Winnebago Security will direct guest to the designated parking area.
